SOCIAL WELFARE ACTIVITIES:

HEALTH PROGRAMME:

The organization has been conducting a health programme "Small family norm and Population Control" by encouraging spacing Method and Sterilization prevent diseases. Promote health priority to mothers and children to safeguard the people against the categories and others infected diseases. This project is sponsored by the Family Welfare Board from Govt. of India medicines are supplied to the poor parents free of cost from Khaddar Health center which provides vitamin oil and other medicines.

NON FORMAL EDUCATION:

Economic poverty is the main backward factor with the people in the project area which is located on enterprise and backward portion of Habra block 24-pgs (a), WEST BENGAL. FOR THEIR EDUCATIONAL BACKWARDNESS IN TERMS OF HIGHER LEVEL OF ILLITERACY. This has in fact, influenced the **SANDESHKHALI MAA-SARODA WOMEN AND WELFARE SOCIETY** to launch Non-formal education in the SONARPUR Block.

During this reporting year, a good number of students of non formal education center got admission in to the formal schools, after completing their studies. Some have already complete their vocational training through our organization.

LEGAL AID:

We organized on one day legal aid awareness camp in our organization campus and 250 people mostly women participated in the camp. Two eminent lawyer discuss details all the Govt. facilities to be taken, the legal rights of women and how to ensure it. Such a camp was not held before this area and it yielded sound response.
